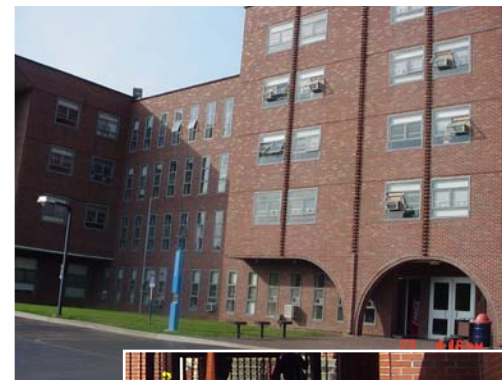

Living on campus at Barat

The Barat campus offers a unique experience to residential students, the opportunity to participate in a small college atmosphere with the resources of a large university at your fingertips.

Modeled after St. Vincent de Paul’s teachings of being a full participant in one’s community, our supportive Residence Hall Community focuses on diversity, respect, community involvement and leadership development. Having you build collaborative relationships with other students, faculty and staff is our top priority.

The recently renovated Old Main building features many opportunities for you to interact with fellow students. There are lounges, computer labs, and dining service areas.

By living in Barat residence halls, you are constantly surrounded by a supportive environment. The ratio of student to resident advisor is 23 to 1, well below the national average of 40 to 1.



Dougherty Hall

Dougherty Hall has five floors and is co-ed by floor. The building features both double and single room accommodations. The building was completely renovated during the summer of 2001. Dougherty can accommodate approximately 260 residents.

Double rooms feature two beds, desks, dressers, and wardrobes. Dougherty has several comfortable lounges, laundry, and vending facilities, as well as a kitchen. The hall also features a newly renovated computer lab. Dougherty is located on the north end of campus.

Merrill Hall

Merrill Hall, which is Barat’s oldest traditional-style residence hall, houses residents in double and single room options. The building has five floors and is co-ed by floor. Merrill can accommodate approximately 150 residents.

In the early nineties, Merrill Hall was outfitted with new furniture and in 1998 a computer lab was added. Laundry facilities are on-site. The hall also features a spacious lounge and study area that overlooks the west end of campus.
